ANNUAL FEES

As agreed at the AGM in June, the fees for 2017/18 have been maintained at the same level as for the previous year - £40 per household. The fees are now due, by cheque payable to Kemnal Residents Association please.

PLANS FOR THE NEW YEAR

First priority will be the improvement of the entrance to Kemnal Road from Ashfield Lane. This area does not give a good welcoming impression to our road. Now that BT have finished their work to install fibre optic cable, we hope to make progress.

PARKING IN KEMNAL ROAD

Like most residential roads in London, Kemnal Road is experiencing greater pressure from visitors wanting to park. In the interests of all our residents, we ask that you bear in mind the following:

- Avoid parking where there are **white lines** at the edge of the road and on humps. This is particularly important at the Dickens Drive junction, where the **white lines** have been laid down to protect vehicles turning into and out of Dickens Drive.
- Please use residential parking facilities wherever possible, to minimise the number of parked vehicles in the road.
- Please refrain from parking near the entrances of blocks of flats as this means that delivery vans, bin lorries etc. find it difficult to gain access.
